4. Poster must be original work of student.

6. Overall poster size Must Not Exceed 14" x 22".
7. All posters must have been made since 2008 Broward County Fair.
8. All posters should promote better human rights.
9. Entrant will be limited to one (1) poster.
10. Posters will be judged on the American System of Judging.
11. Winners will be notified prior to Awards Ceremony, Fri., Nov. 20, 7 pm.
12. Winning Posters become property of the Broward County Fair and will be on display in the Student Exhibit Area throughout the Fair.
