Rules

1. No entry fee.
 2. Use official Broward County Fair Entry Tag. Entry tag may **not** be photocopied and must be filled in completely (excluding Social Security number) or entry will be disqualified.
 3. Participation will be limited to first 40 entries.
 4. See General Information and Premium Information pages.
 5. Exhibitors must be present at all times.
 6. Exhibitors are required to provide proper cages.
- No Exceptions!**
7. Special exhibits and displays must be arranged with Superintendent.
 8. Each exhibitor may enter up to six rabbits. Maximum 12 per family. Entries must be 8 weeks or over (except mother with babies - babies must be under eight weeks.) Mother and babies will be judged as one entry.
 9. Fair is not responsible for animal after checkout time.
 10. The Fair management may decline or reject any exhibit they feel should not be shown.
 11. Long-haired animals must be groomed before entry.
 12. Owners are responsible for providing food for their animals.
 13. Water will be provided by Fair Staff. Owners should provide proper dispenser.
 14. No diseased animal will be allowed in show. We suggest you check your rabbit's ears for canker. No treatment will be allowed at the Fair.
 15. All animals will receive a number imprinted in their ears upon entry (Ink will wear off and not harm animal.) and will serve as their identification during the Fair.
 16. Animals entered as purebred stock must conform to the standard set forth by the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
 17. For Official Entry Tags, contact the Broward County Fair office, 954-922-2224.

Responsibility

The Broward County Fair assumes **NO RESPONSIBILITY** for exhibits left after the removal time deadline. Items not claimed by 6 pm Nov. 30, 2009 will be disposed of by Fair management. All ribbons and/or premium checks are forfeited.

Any questions arising from premium awards, missing prizes, missing or improperly written checks, or other exhibit matters must be submitted in writing to Fair management prior to December 10, 2009. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Rabbits (continued)

Classifications

Class I -

Pure Breeds (Example - New Zealand, Dutch, Netherland Dwarf, Holland Lops, Rex).

Class II -

Mixed breeds or pure breeds that do not conform to the color standards of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.

Class III -

Mother with babies. Babies must have eyes open (10 days old) and cannot be older than eight (8) weeks.
