### Rules

1. No entry fee.
2. Use official Broward County Fair Entry Tag for each entry. Entry tag may **not** be photocopied and must be filled in completely (excluding Social Security number) or entry will be disqualified.
3. Participation will be limited to first 25 entries in Classes 1, 2 & 3.
4. See General Information and Premium Information pages.
5. Exhibitors must be present at all times.
6. Exhibitors are required to provide proper cages.  
**No Exceptions!**
7. Special exhibits and displays must be arranged with Superintendent.
8. Each Exhibitor may enter up to but no more than 5 birds.
9. Fair is not responsible for animal after checkout time.
10. The Fair management may decline or reject any exhibit they feel should not be shown.
11. All birds entered must have been owned and maintained by exhibitor since Jan. 1, 2009.
12. Water will be provided by Fair Staff. Owners should provide proper dispenser..
13. Owners are responsible for providing food for their animals
14. No diseased animal will be allowed in show. No treatment will be allowed at the Fair.
15. All birds must meet A.P.A. or A.B.A. standards to be eligible for premiums.
16. Neither the Poultry Department, Broward County Fair nor its officers or agents will be responsible for any accident, loss, illness, death or damage that may occur.
17. The Department of Agriculture's Poultry Health Requirements covering chickens and turkeys going to public exhibition require that they come from a pullorum-typhoid clean flock or have a negative pullorum-typhoid test within 90 days prior to exhibition. This means that all chickens or turkeys entered for exhibition must be accompanied by a certificate of purchase indicating that the bird came from a pullorum-typhoid clean hatchery, which is participating in the National Poultry or Turkey Improvement Plan. If this certificate is not presented, the chickens or turkeys must have official negative pullorum-typhoid blood tests before they can be admitted.
18. No bird will be accepted unless properly leg banded and numbers of the same are correctly recorded on entry tags. Leg bands will be given to each exhibitor and birds must be banded before they are assigned a coop.
19. This Department is subject to cancellation if directed by the Department of Agriculture.

**Class IV - Eggs**

- Sub-Class:** A. Brown Eggs  
 B. White Eggs  
 C. Green Eggs

**Egg Rules**

1. Large eggs shall average no less than 24 ounces per dozen.
2. No eggs weighing less than 23 ounces shall be included in this category.
3. Extra large eggs shall average no less than 27 ounces per dozen.
4. No eggs weighing less than 26 ounces shall be included in this category.
5. A dozen eggs of medium average weight for this category shall receive as many points, other things being equal, as a dozen eggs of maximum weight for entry.
6. All eggs must be entered as single dozens.
7. One entry in this class per individual.

**Egg Disqualifications**

1. One or more stained eggs.
2. One or more eggs entered in wrong category.
3. One or more eggs with meat spots, germ development, blood clots, stuck yolks, or undesirable color.
4. One or more eggs that are for some reason unfit for human consumption.
5. One or more leaking eggs.
6. Two or more distinctly tinted eggs (in White Egg Class).

**Note:**

**Commercial Birds** are primarily associated with egg production. This group includes male birds that are used for breeding purposes.

**Standard Birds** include those raised mainly for show. This does not mean that they are considered to be poor egg producers.

**Bantam Birds** are miniaturized chickens of any breed; most breeds have a regular and bantam variety.
