Junior (ages 8-10), Intermediate (ages 11-14), Senior (ages 15-18)

Rules

1. No entry fee.
2. Use official Broward County Fair Entry Tag for each entry. Entry tag may **not** be photocopied and must be filled in completely (excluding Social Security number) or entry will be disqualified.
3. Entries must conform to all applicable Premium Book rules & the rules of the Livestock Department.
4. See General Information and Premium Information pages.
5. Animal must be trained by exhibitor at least 90 days before the opening of the Fair.
6. Bulls of breeding age must be shown with nose ring.
7. Judging is based on the Modified Danish System:
 - (a) Registered Beef: Each breed will be judged separately. Males and females will be judged separately. Blue ribbon class winners will return to the ring and be judged for Best of Breed, if there are two or more of the same breed competing. Following this, all Best of Breed winners will return to the ring and be judged for Best Female of Show and Best Male of Show.
 - (b) Non-Registered Beef: Males and females will be returned to the ring and judged for Best Grade Female of Show and Best Grade Male of Show.
8. Fair is not responsible for animal after checkout time.
9. The Fair management may decline or reject any exhibit they feel should not be shown.
10. Any student entering Youth Fitting & Grooming competition must groom their own animal without adult participation, with registered and grade cattle showing together.
11. Fair Management will furnish feed and personnel to help care for animals in the Livestock Department. However, each exhibitor is still held responsible for the health and well being of their livestock. Animals will be watered three (3) times a day. Entrants must supply their own feed and water containers.
12. All animals entering the Fair must enter on time on check-in day and must remain until checkout.
13. Exhibitor will wear a clean, pressed and complete club uniform or other suitable neat attire.
14. To receive premiums all exhibitors will assist with load out and cleanup on Saturday, Nov. 28 from 9 pm until closing.
