Age Divisions

Elementary School Division- Kindergarten through grade 5

Rules

1. No entry fee.
2. Use official Broward County Fair Entry Tag. Affix entry tag to back of entry. Entry tag may **not** be photocopied and must be filled in completely (excluding Social Security number) or entry will be disqualified.
3. Exhibits will be limited to two (2) entries per individual.
4. See General Information and Premium Information pages.
5. No items shall be accepted by mail.
6. All entries will be discarded following judging for sanitary reasons. Only entry tags and recipes will be displayed. All containers and decorations will be discarded.
7. Entrant need not bring entire baked item, a portion will suffice. Examples: 3 muffins, 6 cookies, one substantial slice of pie, cake, bread, etc.
8. All food entries must be wrapped or covered.
9. Entry must be accompanied by a 3 "x 5" card containing recipe on one side and exhibitor's name, address and age division on the reverse. Recipe card and entry tag need to be affixed to entry. Canned entries must also include canning date and contents of jar. Use 2-piece lid and no paraffin sealer.
10. Cake decorating may be on hard forms or inverted disposable cake pans. Include frosting recipe and number of tips used for decorating.
11. No commercially prepared mixes may be used for baked items.
12. All recipes become the property of the Broward County Fair and may be reproduced in whole or in part with or without the participant's name, and with or without the consent of the participant.
